

COMING SOON: FIRST-OF-ITS-KIND, \$70 MILLION RECYCLING EXPANSION

We are thrilled to announce that we are adding a 90,000-square-foot aluminum extrusion and sheet recycling facility to our Rosemount campus, the first of its kind in Minnesota. This investment will allow us to sort and melt post-consumer scrap aluminum, like pop cans, and cast it into sheet and extrusion alloys. There is a growing market for recycled aluminum driven by consumer demand for sustainable products, green building standards, a stable domestic supply chain and cost savings associated with recycled material. The first phase of the project will result in up to 120 million pounds per year of additional recycling capacity and create over 50 new full-time jobs. We will break ground on the project in 2024.

SPECTRO AT THE STATE FAIR

Spectro Alloys partnered with the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency to teach fairgoers about the lifecycle of aluminum right here in Minnesota.
